FRAME CONSTRUCTION:



The Kiln-Drying process will remove approximately 93% of the moisture out of the Wood. This reduction in moisture content is important to ensure the Wood does not Warp nor Shrink with the change in Humidity and Temperature. Warping and Shrinking can quickly destabilize the Furniture Frame.

Our Kiln-Dried Hardwood Frames are constructed with Doweled and Glued Joints secured by using heavy duty Staples and Screws. The Frame is also secured with Corner Blocks placed strategically within the Frame and Screwed into Place for added Strength and Durability. Species: Maple & Oak
